CHATHAM, NY: The Morris Memorial Association is pleased to announce they have been awarded a Mentoring Matters grant for 2010 from First Niagara.

The grant will be used to take youth through the steps of designing and finishing a yearbook to be sent for printing. During the 8-week class youth will learn how to create and follow a timeline for the project, work with a digital camera, operate an iMac computer, create graphics using Photoshop and layout the images in a yearbook format using Adobe InDesign software to be printed as a final product.

The yearbook will consist of all the activities offered by the Morris, both the after school program and sports and enrichment activities offered offsite. Youth in grades 5-8 are encouraged to call the Morris at 392-4622 to register for the class which will run from 3:00-4:30 beginning February 23rd.
